

Special Town Meeting  
November 5, 2025

Town Clerk, Kathleen Klinck called the Special Town Meeting to order at 8:00 pm in the Municipal Office Complex, 1 Plains Road, Moodus, Ct. Approximately twenty (20) people were in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Irene Haines motioned to nominate Kathleen Klinck Moderator, Erik Dill seconded the motion. Other nominations were solicited, none were offered. Irene Haines motioned to close nominations, Julie Piontkowski provided the second. The motion closing nominations carried unanimously via voice vote. The Moderator called for a vote on the nomination of Kathleen Klinck to serve as Moderator, the motion carried unanimously via voice vote.

The Moderator reviewed the protocols for the meeting and called for a motion that the legislative body herein assembled accept the call of the meeting as presented. Erik Dill motioned to accept the call as presented, Irene Haines provided the second. There being no discussion, the motion accepting the call as presented carried unanimously via voice vote.

Item #1. Robert Casner motioned, Irene Haines provided the second that the legislative body herein assembled consider and act upon the the recommendation of the Board of Selectmen and Board of Finance to accept a grant in the amount of \$8,256.84 from the State of Connecticut, Office of the Secretary of the State for the purpose of costs related to implementing and conducting early voting upon the terms and conditions set forth in an Agreement between The State of Connecticut, Office of the Secretary of the State and the Town of East Haddam.

Opportunity for discussion was offered. Melissa Ziobron asked what are the costs associated with early voting. The Moderator told her to check with the Registrar of Voters. The Moderator called for a vote on the motion authorizing the Board of Selectmen and the Board of Finance to accept a grant in the amount of \$8,256.84 from the State of Connecticut, Office of the Secretary of the State for the purpose of costs related to implementing and conducting early voting. The motion carried unanimously via voice vote.

Item 2: Irene Haines motioned, Todd Gelston provided the second that the legislative body herein assembled consider and act upon the recommendation of the Board of Selectmen and Board of Finance to accept a grant in the amount of \$5,447.45 from the State of Connecticut, Department of Emergency Services & Public Protection, Division of Emergency Management and Homeland Security, entitled

"FY 2024 Emergency Management Performance Grant", (revenue account 10542-43000 and expense account 10542070-51590)

Opportunity for discussion was offered. There was none. The Moderator called for a vote on the motion authorizing the Board of Selectmen and the Board of Finance to accept a grant in the amount of \$5,447.45 from the State of Connecticut, Department of Emergency Services & Public Protection, Division of Emergency Management and Homeland Security, entitled "FY 2024 Emergency Management Performance Grant". The motion carried unanimously via voice vote.
