Christine Ohlman is the “Beehive Queen”, musicologist and long-time vocalist with the SNL band, Christine has earned her reputation as the artist who will maximize any performance with her legendary voice and electrifying stage presence.

Her resume’ reads like the “Who’s Who” of blues, rock and soul royalty and is matched by respective awards; among them, induction into the National Blues Hall of Fame. Mixing a fiery blend of “rootsy” Americana with old school soul, Ohlman, with her long time collaborator Rebel Montez, tells her audiences, “I’ve come to set your souls on fire... and she will.

Moto plays a mix of styles including Reggae, Calypso, Soca (think Hot, Hot, Hot), and their own interpretations of Pop and R&B material; all with an island feel. With steel drums and island rhythms, the music is perfect for warm

summer nights, sunsets and happy crowds. Their approach to the music is to keep it fresh and exciting, creating spontaneous “mash-ups” to share with the audience.

The band members have played many top CT and New England venues as members of former bands including L&B All Star Review, TireBiter, The Modeans, Basically Blues, and Small Pond All Stars.
