#### **Directions:**

#### Option 1

- From Route 82, follow Mt.
   Parnassus Road east.
- Take a left on Wickham Road.
- Follow Wickham Road for about 1 mile.
- Turn left onto Daniel Peck Road.
- The preserve entrance is on the right after Beebe Road.

#### Option 2

- From Route 82, follow Mt.
   Parnassus Road east.
- Take a left on Wickham Road.
- Follow Wickham Road for about 1 mile.
- Turn left onto Daniel Peck Road
- Turn right onto Beebe Road.

NOTE: Parking is on the side of the street and is limited so watch when turning around as there are ditches to be avoided.

#### **Trail Facts:**


- The .4 mile white trail is accessed from Daniel Peck Road or from Beebe Road.
- The .2 mile red trail is accessed from the white trail. It leads directly to a nice view of the Moodus Reservoir.

### **WILLIAM JEZEK PRESERVE**

The 18.5 acre East Haddam Land
Trust preserve is located in the
middle of a subdivision. The trails
ramble through several wetlands,
and one provides access to upper
Moodus Reservoir. The land hosts a
moderate-aged oak/beech/red
maple forest with several wetlands,
a small brook flowing into the
reservoir, stone walls, and moderate
slopes. This is a fragile wetland
wildlife habitat so special care while
exploring it is requested.
