Directions:

- From Bashan Road southbound,
 turn left on Newberry Road. After
 .57 miles, preserve parking will be
 on your left.
- From Mt. Parnassus Road heading east, turn left (north) onto Schulman Veselak Road. Turn left onto Newberry Road and parking will be on your right.

NOTE: This preserve passes through wet terrain in some places.

Appropriate footwear may be required during or after wet weather.

- The 0.7 mile red trail passes through both wetlands and uplands and follows the bank of a long stream along the preserve's western edge.


The 28.49-acre Lord Wellington property was acquired by the Town of East Haddam in 2002 with the assistance of a grant from the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection.

The property's name derives from Lord Wellington Cone, who was a local property owner in the 1850s.

There is a single loop trail on the property, accessible from the parking area on Newberry Road.
