TRANSFER STATION RESIDENTS GUIDE

EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026—JUNE 30, 2028

Accepted - No Charge

Items must be sorted and Unloaded at proper location - see signage on-site or ask attendant.

- Municipal Solid Waste - Household trash
- Clean Aluminum cans donations are given to Boy Scouts Local Troop
- Clean Recycling (see town website [A Guide To Recycling](#)) All items should be empty, rinsed, clean and open. **Cardboard should be flattened and separated from all other recycling**
- Textiles including: Clothing, Linens, towels, shoes & Bedding of any condition
- Books
- Clean Mattresses (Soiled Mattresses or Box Springs will be charged \$10 each)
- Scrap Metal
- Consumer Electronics, computers, media players and televisions
- Fluorescent Bulbs (unbroken)
- Used Motor Oil and Filters
- Antifreeze
- Batteries
- Leaves ONLY (no plastic bags, wood, logs, shrubs, brush)
- Empty Propane tanks (20lbs or less)
- Food Scraps (Starter Kits available \$10.00 at scale - See attendant or Town Clerks Office) 50% off SALE (NO BAGS)

BIANNUAL PERMITS

Two Biannual Permits (Stickers) will be provided per household. Documentation of residency is required. Documentation must be in the form of a Current Year Town of East Haddam Real Estate/Vehicle Tax Bill or Vehicle Registration showing owner's name and East Haddam Address and Valid State issued License/Identification. Biannual Window sticker Must be affixed to front driver side interior windshield for access to the transfer station.

Residents can obtain a third or fourth biannual permit by purchasing for \$10.00 per permit. A maximum of 4 permits will be issued per household. Payments can be made at the weigh station, online at the Town of East Haddam Website or Public Works during business hours.

Residents must renew their permits biannually online or at the Public Works Garage located at 7 Hood Lane, East Haddam, CT 06423. Public Works will be processing applications and giving out permits May 15th – June 30th, Monday through Thursday 8am – 11am or 1pm – 2pm. Permits are only valid during the permit years which run 7/1 – 6/30 of the permit years. There is no proration or carryover into the next calendar year. Applications with a copy of your state issued photo identification can be emailed to publicworks@easthaddam.org; please allow 14 business days for processing.

Biannual permits are required to be affixed to your vehicle windshield, bottom driver side for access to the Transfer Station.

Transfer Station will no longer accept Cash after 9/2/2024 - Credit/Debit Cards accepted for a small fee and Checks accepted at NO FEE

“What Not Corner”

The What Not Corner is for gently used goods. The Town of East Haddam in no way warrants any item in the “What Not Corner” as safe to handle, transport or use. Anyone taking an item assumes total responsibility and will be taking at own risk.

- If you wouldn't take it, please don't leave it!
- The “What Not Corner” is open to donations of items that are safe, hygienic and NOT BROKEN.
- Please place all small items on shelves and larger items neatly against the wall on the floor
- Residents with a Transfer Station Permit Sticker may take from or donate to the “What Not Corner” From opening to one hour prior to closing. **What Not Corner will close one hour prior to Transfer Station scheduled Closing. Plan accordingly for donation or pick up.**
- At end of the day items that do not fit or are deemed less likely to be taken may be disposed of as trash. The Attendants have discretion to refuse items.
- Parking Limit: 15 minutes per visit/15 minutes per day **NO LOITERING NO EXCEPTIONS. Attendants take notice and will enforce.**

Items Not Accepted: Children's Car Seats, Children's High Chairs or Safety Equipment, Mattresses, Overstuffed or Upholstered Furniture, Adult Books or Toys, Alcohol, Clothing or Textiles, Shoes, Stuffed Animals

Helpful Information

- The Transfer Station is only for East Haddam Residents' disposal of waste generated at home.
- Biannual Permit Stickers **MUST** be affixed to the front windshield. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- If you have a question or need assistance, please ask Attendant.
- Absolutely **NO PICKING** unless in the "What Not Corner". See the attendant if unclear.
- Keep children inside the vehicle or with you at all times.
- Contractor* waste is NOT accepted without a Temporary Contractors Permit available at The Public Works Department See Town Website for more information
- Commercial waste** or trash from a business is NOT accepted without a Commercial Permit See town Website for more information
- Permits can be used to access any town facility including town beach and town dock
- **Credit Cards** will be accepted at the Transfer station **replacing the use of Cash**. Cash will be **accepted through Labor Day 2024**. A minimum \$1.50 charge will be charged on all Credit Card Purchases up to \$57.00 otherwise a 2.65% charge will be added to all transactions over \$57.00 Checks will continue to be accepted at no charge.
- **Cash will NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER LABOR DAY (9/2/2024)**

*Definition of a Contractor. A Contractor is a person who brings materials to Transfer Station not generated from their personal real estate in East Haddam. Contractor lives out of town and is doing work on a home located in the Town. Attendants reserve the right to ask for any documentation to authenticate the origin of the material.

** Definition of Commercial Waste. Commercial waste is waste created from a business registered in the Town of East Haddam doing business in the Town of East Haddam. This includes recycling waste. Commercial waste will be charged at \$120 per ton. All in town businesses must register for a commercial permit. More information can be found on the town website or contact Public Works.

NOT Accepted - Bulky Waste

- ⇒ **Concrete, Asphalt, Masonry Blocks** find where to bring items here https://portal.ct.gov/-/media/DEEP/reduce_reuse_recycle/Construction_and_Demolition/VolumeReductionPlantspdf.pdf
- ⇒ **Stumps, Dirt, Sod, Rocks**
- ⇒ **Leaves in plastic bags** Leaves are accepted loose or in paper bags
- ⇒ **Grass Clippings** Do Not Deposit in road or storm sewers, best left on lawn as mulch
- ⇒ **Hazardous Waste** Community Hazardous waste collection schedule is posted yearly on Town Website

NOT Accepted -

Recycling

- ⇒ Trash or Food waste
- ⇒ Needles or syringes
- ⇒ Hazardous or Bio-hazardous waste
- ⇒ Plastic Bags
- ⇒ Shredded Paper
- ⇒ Garden Hoses
- ⇒ Styrofoam
- ⇒ Bulk Waste
