The Transfer Station hours are:

Monday 7am-5pm

Saturday 7am – 2pm

- Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) is accepted at the transfer station by Residents of the Town of East Haddam.
- Residential household trash is currently accepted at the transfer station at no charge.
- Residents must have a permit affixed to their vehicle to use the Transfer Station.
 - Permits can be picked up at the Transfer station with valid proof of residency.
- MSW should be in household sized garbage bags or similar. The waste should be disposed of into the compactors located on the right-hand side of the drive.
- UPDATE: The rear HOPPER and Front HOPPER will not be open to the public effective 3/1/23 and all waste must go into the compactors.
- MSW that is larger and can not fit into compactors such as furniture and other larger items must be weighed over the scale and paid for at the rate of \$120 per ton.
- Cash or Check is accepted.
- All Recyclable materials are to be disposed of into the compactors at the right of the drive.

NOTE: NO RECYCALBES can go over the scale effective immediately

- Acceptable Items:
 - Newspapers and Inserts
 - Magazines/Brochures
 - Carboard – Paperboard boxes (cereal, egg Cartons)
 - Larger boxes should be broken down prior to arrival – larger carboard will no longer be allowed over the scale and must be put into available compactors.
 - Paper Bags
 - Junk Mail
 - Phone books/Catalogs
 - Office Paper
 - Glass Food/Beverage containers
 - Tin Cans
 - Aluminum cans
 - Aluminum Foil
 - Plastic containers, Milk Jugs, Soda and detergent bottles

- Unacceptable Items:
 - Trash or Food Waste in ANY ITEMS
 - Needles or syringes
 - Hazardous or Biohazardous waste
 - Any items in PLASTIC BAGS
 - Shredded paper
 - Garden hoses
 - Styrofoam
 - Electronics
 - Bulk Waste
 - All other non-recyclable items belong in trash or bulk waste.
- Bulky Waste is accepted and must go over the scale. The charge is \$120 per ton.
 - Items Accepted
 - Burnable – Logs, sticks, brush, shrubs, small root masses, carpeting, lumber, wood fencing, wood deck materials and furniture
 - Demolition – Non Burnable – Sheet rock, plaster, asphalt material, roofing, tile, rocks and concrete under 6 inches in diameter
 - Metal – Mowers, Bicycles, Storm Doors & Railings, Pipe
- Other Miscellaneous Items:
 - Items accepted:
 - Appliances
 - Household Electronics including TV's, Computers, Thermostats
 - Fluorescent lights
 - Batteries
 - Mattresses
 - Tires –\$2.00 per tire payable at scale house. If you are disposing of tires drive to scale before dumping tires into tire dumpster
